

Non-Temporary Storage (NTS) of Household Goods (HHG) for Duty at an Isolated Permanent Duty Station (PDS) in the Continental United States (CONUS) (FTR § 302-8.108)

Time Limitation for Eligibility Termination and Extension

Scenario 1: A civilian employee's last day of work at a designated isolated permanent duty station (PDS) in the continental United States (CONUS) is August 31, 2009, and storage eligibility ends on that day. Non-temporary storage (NTS) at Government expense may continue until the beginning of the 2nd month after the month the civilian employee's eligibility ends. Command approves a storage extension to the 90th day after the last day of work at the PDS.

Storage eligibility ends.	August 31, 2009
Storage may continue until the beginning of the	
2nd month after August 31.	October 1, 2009
 1st month after August: September 	
 2nd month after August: October 	
Storage extension approved to the 90th day after	
the last day of work at the PDS. Add 90 days to	November 29, 2009
the last day of work: August 31 + 90 days.	

Time Limitation for Eligibility Termination and Extension

Scenario 2: A civilian employee's last day of work at a designated isolated PDS in the CONUS is August 4, 2009, and storage eligibility ends on that day. NTS at Government expense may continue until the beginning of the 2nd month after the month the civilian employee's eligibility ends. Command approves a storage extension to the 90th day after the last day of work at the PDS.

Storage eligibility ends.	August 4, 2009
Storage may continue until the beginning of the	
2nd month after August 4.	October 1, 2009
 1st month after August: September 	
 2nd month after August: October 	
Storage extension approved to the 90th day after	
the last day of work at the PDS. Add 90 days to	November 2, 2009
the last day of work: August 4 + 90 days.
