Excess Charges - HHG Transportation in Excess of Authorized Weight Allowance (JTR, par. 051306-B)

Note: The rates and costs in this example may not be current and are for illustrative purposes only.

Scenario: A Service member with a weight allowance of 8,000 pounds transports 8,500 pounds of authorized articles. The cost to transport the total weight of 8,500 pounds is \$5,000. The cost of the excess net weight (500 pounds) is prorated based on the cost of total net weight transported (500/8,500). The Service member is financially responsible for \$300.

Computing Excess Cost

Authorized weight	8,000 lbs.
Weight actually transported	8,500 lbs.
Excess net weight	8,500-8,000=500 lbs.
Ratio used for prorated cost of excess net weight	500/8,500=0.06
Cost to transport total weight (8,500 lbs.)	\$5,000
Cost for excess weight	\$5,000×0.06=\$300
